PART 1 - Admissions to the 2022/2023 school year

Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2022/2023 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

1. The school will commence accepting applications for admission	4th October 2021
2. The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	1 st November 2021 on or before 23:59
3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	Within 3 weeks of the closing date for applications
4. The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	One week from the date of offer

Note: Applications made after 1st November 2021 will be processed as late applications, the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn.

Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to Stepside Educate Together National school for 2022/2023 school year should a place / places become available.

There must be a recommendation within a psychological assessment or a report from a member of a multi-disciplinary team that a special class placement in a mainstream school is both necessary and suitable for the child.

The following are the dates applicable for admission to the school's Special Class which caters for children with a primary diagnosis of Autism.

Note: The figures set out below in relation to the Special Class are subject to change dependent on whether current students in the Special Classes retain their place in the school and whether a student(s) transfers into the school after the publication of this Notice.

The school will commence accepting applications for admission to the special class on	7 th February 2022
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission to the special class on	28 th February 2022
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application for admission to the special class is	Within 3 weeks of the closing date for applications
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	One week from date of offer

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn

The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	Within 3 weeks of the closing date for applications
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	One week from the date of offer

Note: Applications made after 1st November 2021 will be processed as late applications, the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
